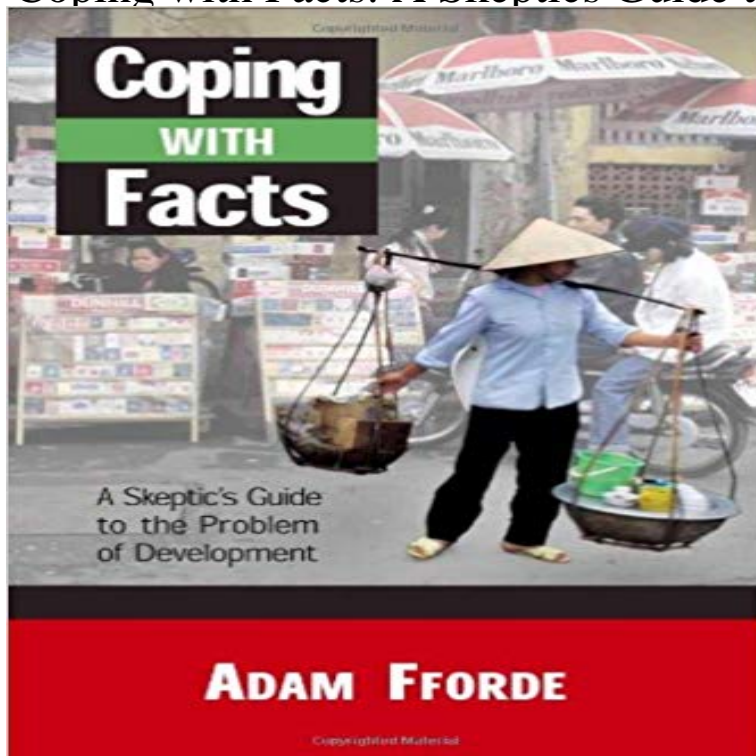


Coping with Facts: A Skeptics Guide to the Problem of Development
