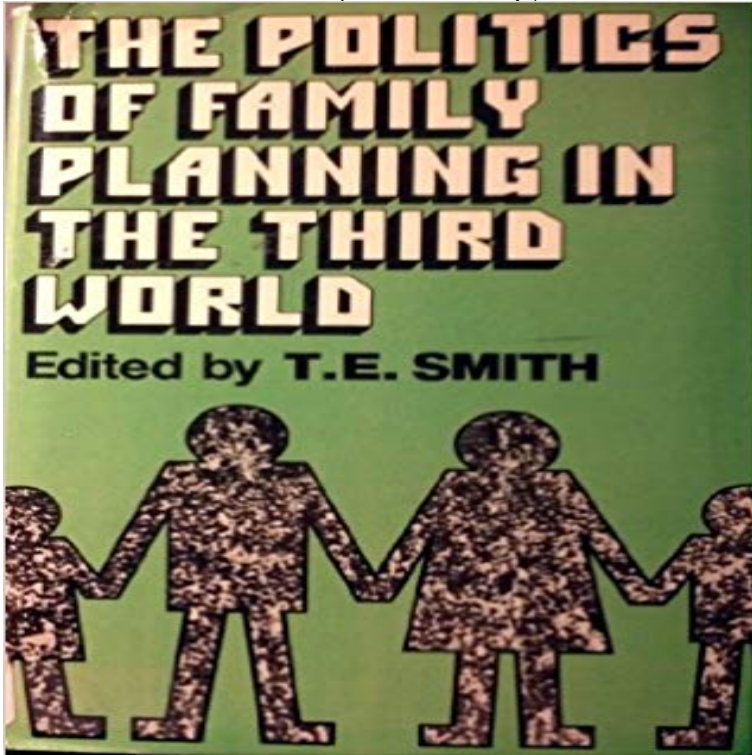


Politics of Family Planning in the Third World
